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コンセプト：

空間、このコンセプトは西洋都市基本構想に対して飛躍的に極めて矛盾している。

大都会において一個人に対する空間は、すべての局面のもとにあり、
生命境界線、自分のための時間、自己形成

それは基本と化している。しかしながら、まさにこの点において私は現実空間の分析に直面することに興味を引かれ、この膨大な雑踏の中に新たな空間に対する概念を作り出すために、それを論議し空間に形を与えようとしているのである。

従ってTokyospaceは、この東洋のダウンタウンにおける私の創造空間である。これは、単なるドキュメンテーションを超えた形而上リフレクションを作り出すため、既存であると同時に分析的には分離された環境へ挿入された私の空間である。つまりこの空間は、科学、化学、物理学の実験室、高技術ソフトウェア・・・スライド、チップ、電子顕微鏡のようなものである。

Tokyospaceの基本的な特徴の一つとして、動き、つまり物理的、精神的な旅、が挙げられる。私達の現実を展開、あるいは論議するために、特定の瞬間にビデオと写真を通じて遭遇した現実の光景に注目し、焦点を当てている。従って、私の行動する場所は、自然/都会という次元での光景である。絶えず再定義を受けやすい、そして無限に影響を受けやすい風景や外空間などが理想的な領域だと私は思う。常に変形し続ける、作り出された空間や建築物は、私の行動のしるしとなる。進化し孤立した人間やサイバーの存在は、あたかも微生物管理された無菌環境の中で行動しているかのようである。

従って、私の見る現実は、この特定の都市空間の様々な角度に向けられると同時に、個人と建築群の間にある密接な空間に向けられる。



プロジェクト：

この東京との接触で、新たな作品シリーズが生まれるだろう。それらの作品は、この新次元への分析的、創造的な私のアプローチを、ビデオ・写真のエラボレーションを介して反映するものである。

そのスピードと無制限さで特徴付けられる現在のメディアを以ってこのウェブプロジェクト<http://www.tokyospace.com>は、閉ざされた空間の欠如に関する概念を展開する。

Tokyospace by Stefano Cagol stages mutual exchange between individual and shared space within a glocal dimension par excellence: the megalopolis of Tokyo. At a conceptual level the whole project brings back to the principle of Leibnitz' monads, i.e. a closed organism representing a point of view on the universe and which, in virtue of this point of view, inevitably bounces again onto the outside. The monad, or better the artist's creative space, stands for intimacy, subjective dimension, but it becomes also permeability, constant reflex of a surrounding space.

In his recent artistic production, Stefano Cagol has become increasingly interested in the perception of space, both fictitious and concrete. His research is brought forth with video and photography which are mainly used because of their anti-documental qualities, their investigative and evocative character. Approached visions as well as amplifications of the surrounding context become metaphor of the various modalities of space reception in the complex relationship world-I. At the same time, Stefano Cagol's work in progress is part of the long tradition which uses photography as a filing process; the Tokyospace images become a sort of archive of our everyday life in which meaningless details set up elements of a bigger interest of wide sights. His video shots and pictures are thus the expression of a peculiar and highly subjective moment that invites us to think again about the whole system of a megalopolis in terms of human fruition, therefore never the same and endlessly undergoing visual and emotional mutations.

Concept:

Space here the concept is extremely contradictory in an exponential manner in relation to the scheme of Western cities.

In a MEGALOPOLIS, the space for a single person becomes under all aspects – vital perimeter, time for one's self, satisfaction of the individual – reduced to the essence. However it is right here that I am interested in facing an analysis of actual space by putting it into discussion, and by planning to give form to a space on my own, a personal dimension of analysis able to create and to take forcefully place in this enormous ant's nest.

Tokyospace is thus my creative space in this Western downtown. My space is inserted into a pre-existing environment and at the same time detached in an analytical way in order to create a metaphysical reflection which goes beyond mere documentation. A scientific, chemical, and physical laboratory, a highly valuable technological software... a slide, a chip, an electronic microscope.

A fundamental characteristic of tokyospace is the one of movement, of a physical and mental journey. Attention is focalized on close visions of reality, met and immortalized through video and photography in a precise moment, aiming to amplify or put into discussion our actual reality. The place in which I move is therefore for me the landscape, meant as a natural/urban dimension. I find that environment, outside space, is an ideal territory, open to a continuous re-definition and to endless contaminations. A structured space, architecture, becomes a witness in constant transformation of my displacements; as much as the detached, evolved, cyber, human presence moves as if inside an aseptic area with a microbiologically controlled atmosphere.

My close vision will thus be turned to various declinations of this specific metropolitan space, and in the meantime space of infinity, between the single individual and the conglomerate.

Project:

My contact with Tokyo will trigger a new series of artworks which will translate my analytical and creative approach to this new dimension through video and photographic elaboration.

This visual work in progress will then be shown in collaboration with Johnnie Walker of the Tokyo AsArt Foundation on September 24, 2004 (to be confirmed).

The web project <http://www.tokyospace.com> characterized by both the speed and the unlimitedness of current media, amplifies the idea of absence of a close spatiality.

The project is created in collaboration with the Galleria Civica di Arte Contemporanea of Trento, Italy.

Tokyospace di Stefano Cagol mette in scena il reciproco scambio tra spazio individuale e spazio condiviso all'interno di una dimensione *glocal* per eccellenza: la megalopoli di Tokyo. L'intero progetto rinvia concettualmente al principio della monade leibniziana, ovvero ad un organismo chiuso, che rappresenta un punto di vista sull'universo e che proprio in virtù di questo punto di vista rimanda inevitabilmente all'esterno. La monade, o meglio lo spazio creativo dell'artista, è intimità, è dimensione soggettiva, ma è anche permeabilità, riflesso costante di una dimensione circostante.

Nella recente produzione artistica Stefano Cagol si è sempre più interessato alla percezione dello spazio sia fittizio che concreto. Questa ricerca viene portata avanti attraverso i medium del video e della fotografia, i quali vengono impiegati principalmente per le loro qualità anti-documentaristiche, per il loro carattere di indagine ed evocazione. Visioni ravvicinate così come amplificazioni del contesto circostante diventano metafora delle diverse modalità di ricezione spaziale nel complesso rapporto io-mondo. Al contempo il work in progress di Stefano Cagol si inserisce nella lunga tradizione dell'impiego della fotografia come schedatura; le immagini di *tokyospace* diventano una sorta di archivio del quotidiano, in cui particolari insignificanti e dettagli costituiscono elementi di maggiore interesse di ampie panoramiche. Le riprese video e gli scatti fotografici diventano dunque espressione di un peculiare momento altamente soggettivo, che invita a ripensare l'intero sistema della megalopoli in termini di fruizione umana e dunque mai uguale a sé stesso e incessantemente sottoposto a mutazioni sia visive che emotive.

Concept:

Lo spazio, qui questo concetto è estremamente contraddittorio, in modo esponenziale rispetto allo schema della città occidentale. Nella MEGALOPOLI lo spazio per la singola persona è in tutti i sensi - perimetro vitale, tempo per se stessi, realizzazione dell'individuo - ridotto all'essenza. Eppure, proprio qui intendo affrontare un'analisi dello spazio reale attuale, mettendolo in discussione e progettando di dare forma a un mio spazio, una mia dimensione d'analisi capace di creare e prendere posto con forza in questo enorme formicaio.

Tokyospace è quindi il mio spazio creativo in questa downtown orientale. Il mio spazio inserito nell'ambiente preesistente e allo stesso tempo distaccato in modo analitico, tanto da creare una riflessione meta-fisica, che va

oltre la pura documentazione. Un laboratorio scientifico, chimico e fisico software ad altissimo valore tecnologico... un vetrino, un chip, un microscopio elettronico.

Una caratteristica fondamentale di tokyospace è quella del movimento, del viaggio, fisico e mentale. L'attenzione si focalizza su visioni ravvicinate della realtà, incontrata e immortalata attraverso i media di video e fotografia in precisi momenti, in modo da amplificare o mettere in discussione il reale attuale. Il luogo dove muovermi è quindi per me il paesaggio, inteso come una dimensione naturale/urbana. Trovo il paesaggio, lo spazio esterno, un territorio ideale, aperto alla continua ridefinizione e infinite contaminazioni. Lo spazio costruito, l'architettura, diviene testimone in costante trasformazione dei miei spostamenti; così come la presenza umana, cyber, evoluta e distaccata, si muove come all'interno di un area asettica con atmosfera microbiologicamente controllata.

La mia visione ravvicinata sarà dunque rivolta alle diverse declinazioni di questo specifico spazio metropolitano e nel contempo spazio di intimità, tra il singolo individuo e l'agglomerato.

Project:

Il contatto con Tokyo darà vita a una nuova serie di opere che tradurranno il mio approccio analitico e creativo a questa nuova dimensione attraverso l'elaborazione video e fotografica.
